



PAYDAY LOTTERY GAME CONDITIONS

These Game Conditions apply, until amended or revised, to the PAYDAY lottery game.

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 PAYDAY is governed by the Rules Respecting Lottery Games of the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation (the "Corporation") which are available upon request and which include limitations of liability.
- 1.2 Words used in the PAYDAY Game Conditions which are used in the Rules Respecting Lottery Games shall have the same meaning as those used in the Rules Respecting Lottery Games.

2.0 Game Participation

- 2.1 A player may play one or more selections. For each selection the player shall select for the \$1,000 A Week For Life prize category four numbers from the class 77 consecutive numbers of one to 77.
- 2.2 The on-line system shall choose for the player 14 additional sets of four computer-generated numbers from the class of one to 77, which shall be valid for and assigned to the following prize categories:
 - (a) two sets of four numbers for the \$50,000 prize category;
 - (b) four sets of four numbers for the \$20,000 prize category; and,
 - (c) eight sets four of numbers for the \$1,000 prize category.
- 2.3 Quick Pick, Advance Play and Repurchase play are also available.

3.0 The Draw

On the date of a draw, the Corporation shall draw at random and without repetition, four numbers ("winning number") from the class of 77 consecutive numbers from one to 77.

4.0 Prize Structure

- 4.1 Prizes for this lottery game shall be determined based on the four winning numbers drawn and the prize category the set of numbers chosen (by the player and/or the on-line system) matches horizontally on the ticket. Prizes are based on a fixed prize structure and the possible payout is as follows:

(a)

\$1,000 A Week For Life	4 of 4	\$1,000 A Week For Life ("annuity prize")
\$50,000	4 of 4	\$50,000
\$20,000	4 of 4	\$20,000
\$1,000	4 of 4	\$1,000

(b) Subsidiary Prizes:

<u>Prize Categories</u>	<u>Numbers Matched</u>	<u>Prize Amount</u>
\$1,000 A Week For Life	3 of 4	\$25
\$50,000	3 of 4	\$25
\$20,000	3 of 4	\$25
\$1,000	3 of 4	\$25
\$1,000 A Week For Life	2 of 4	\$2
\$50,000	2 of 4	\$2
\$20,000	2 of 4	\$2
\$1,000	2 of 4	\$2

There is only one prize available to be won per set of numbers.

- 4.2 The Corporation limits the number of \$1,000 A Week For Life prizes per draw (as listed above in paragraph 5.1.a) to a total of four prizes. Should the aggregate number of the \$1,000 A Week For Life annuity prizes exceed the four prizes, the annuity prizes will not be available and each prize in that prize category will be paid as a single cash payment determined by dividing \$2,700,000 by the number of the winning sets of numbers in the \$1,000 A Week For Life prize category for that draw. A group play winning set of numbers in the \$1,000 A Week For Life prize category is considered to be one winner.

5.0 Miscellaneous

- 5.1 The Corporation may amend these Game Conditions at any time and in any manner.
- 5.2 The headings in these Game Conditions are for convenience of reference only and do not affect the interpretation of these Game Conditions.
- 5.3 Unless otherwise specified by the Corporation, these Game Conditions are confirmed to be effective and supersede previous Rules for the PAYDAY lottery game as of November 12, 2008.
