00:00:14,280 --> 00:00:19,240 or "bust" – you lose the hand. Highest winning hand possible is 'BLACKJACK',

00:00:19,240 --> 00:00:26,280 which is a ten-value card and an ace as the first two cards you're dealt.

00:00:26,280 --> 00:00:32,000 After bets are placed, the dealer will deal each player two cards – both facing up.

00:00:32,000 --> 00:00:37,240 Here's something you'll need to know: Cards two through ten are taken at face value.

00:00:37,240 --> 00:00:44,320 Face cards – Jacks, Queens and Kings – are each worth ten. And aces are worth one OR eleven,

00:00:44,320 --> 00:00:49,000 depending on how you want to use them. Now to playing Blackjack...Blackjack is

9

00:00:49,000 --> 00:00:53,800 a game of strategy, and by applying it you can improve your odds of winning.

00:00:53,800 --> 00:00:59,200 It can help you with decisions on whether to hit, stay, split or double down –we'll

11

00:00:59,200 --> 00:01:03,600 explain these actions in a moment. Remember, you can always ask your dealer

00:01:10,840 --> 00:01:14,440 If you have an eight and a king. That's eighteen. Pretty close to

00:01:14,440 --> 00:01:20,040 21. The odds suggest that you 'stay'. Let's get back to aces and explain how

00:01:20,040 --> 00:01:25,800 they work...let's say you have sixteen in your hand and, using basic strategy, you decide to

00:01:25,800 --> 00:01:31,840 hit to get another card, and you get an ace. Knowing that the ace has two values, counting

00:01:31,840 --> 00:01:39,120 it as 11 would put you over 21, or "bust" your hand, which means you lose the round. Instead,

00:01:39,120 --> 00:01:44,920 by assigning a value of one, you'll have seventeen and still have a pretty good chance of winning!

00:01:44,920 --> 00:01:50,200 Now if the dealer gets "Blackjack" right off the bat then everybody automatically loses,

00:01:50,200 --> 00:01:54,200 unless of course, the other players have Blackjack. If this happens,

00:01:54,200 --> 00:01:59,840 they keep their bets. Actually, any time a player ties the dealer, they get to keep their bets.

00:02:00,880 --> 00:02:04,920 Now let's talk about 'hitting'. After the initial deal, players can ask for

00:02:04,920 --> 00:02:11,800 an extra card, say, if they have a ten or less. To "hit" you would do this.

00:02:11,800 --> 00:02:16,240 Let's say you have 17 or over and you are satisfied with your total, you would want to

00:02:16,240 --> 00:02:23,800 'stay'. To 'stay' you would go like 'this'. That means no more cards.

26

00:02:23,800 --> 00:02:27,440 If you have a pair, like eights, you may want to split them. You

27

00:02:27,440 --> 00:02:32,440 indicate you want to split by doing this. 'Splitting' your hand gives you a better

28

00:02:32,440 --> 00:02:38,680 chance to win as you are now playing two hands, but keep in mind it forces you to double your bet.

29

00:02:38,680 --> 00:02:42,880 Finally, there's another play called 'doubling down'. After you've been dealt your first two

00:02:42,880 --> 00:02:48,640 cards, you have an option of doubling your initial bet — but you only get one additional card.

The best time to double down is when the dealer is showing a 'bust card',

32 00:02:52,040 --> 00:02:56,400 typically a five or a six. This is because there's a pretty good chance the dealer's

00:02:56,400 --> 00:03:03,520 other card is a ten or face card, increasing the odds that the dealer will bust on their next draw.
