When it comes to roulette, you should know that there's no skill needed

to play the game. It is purely a game of chance. And it's simple.

Basic gameplay revolves around guessing what number, or colour, you think the ball will land

on. If you guess right, you win!

Let's learn a little more before

we find out where this one's gonna
land. Let's start with the chips...

You choose the value of your chips when
you buy in at the table and make sure you

cash out before you leave, because
they only have value at that table.

Now that we have chips to bet
with, let's learn how to bet!

Ok, there are two kinds of betting in roulette
– outside betting and inside betting.

00:00:49,160 --> 00:00:54,440

Let's begin with outside bets.

Stick to outside bets for better odds of winning,

00:00:54,440 --> 00:00:59,920

but just know they offer lower payouts. And
remember there are no guarantees of winning

12

00:00:59,920 --> 00:01:06,240

because the result of every spin is random.

With outside betting, all bets lie on the

13

00:01:06,240 --> 00:01:12,280

outside of the betting area.

You can bet red or black...

14

00:01:12,280 --> 00:01:19,160

Evens or odds...

and high or low.

15

00:01:19,160 --> 00:01:26,120

Each have 1 to 1 payouts. That means, if you bet twenty-five dollars, you'll double your money!

16

00:01:26,120 --> 00:01:31,680

You can also make column bets right here. These pay out at 2 to 1.

17

00:01:31,680 --> 00:01:33,840

Now, let's talk inside betting...

18

00:01:33,840 --> 00:01:37,920

Inside betting has lower odds of winning, but higher payouts.

19

00:01:37,920 --> 00:01:42,960

The simplest bet is a “straight up”.

That is placing a bet on a single number,

20

00:01:42,960 --> 00:01:47,240

like this. A one-dollar bet could win you \$35.

21

00:01:47,240 --> 00:01:49,960

But you can also split two numbers...

22

00:01:49,960 --> 00:01:56,120

Bet a four-number corner....

Or a street.

23

00:01:56,120 --> 00:01:59,840

Is there a strategy to winning at roulette?

24

00:02:00,480 --> 00:02:04,200

There is no strategy to picking numbers

because you never know where the ball

25

00:02:04,200 --> 00:02:10,760

will land. Each spin is an entirely new event
and past spins don't influence future ones.
