

PlaySmart – ‘Get Your Game On’ – Mini Baccarat

Text on screen:

PlaySmart
‘Get Your Game On’ - MINI BACCARAT

Voiceover:

*Today we’re going to learn how to play Mini Baccarat.
Mini Baccarat is a great game for new players.
It’s basically just a guessing game...which makes it very easy to play.
Here’s how it works, Two, two-card hands will be dealt by the dealer. One hand is called, ‘The Banker’
and the other is called ‘The Player’. You simply pick which hand you think will hit closest to 9.*

Text on screen:

PlaySmart Tip: Hands are dealt to PLAYER and BANKER spots, not to players at the table.

Voiceover:

*Let’s learn how to bet, shall we? There are three ways to bet.
You can bet on “The Player”...
“The Banker”...
Or you can bet on a tie.*

Text on screen:

PlaySmart Tip: There are three ways to bet - on the PLAYER, on the BANKER, or on a TIE.

Voiceover:

*Both “The Banker” and “The Player” hands have one-to-one odds. That means if you bet 10 dollars and
win, you can look forward to 10 dollars in winnings coming your way!
Ties payout at 8 to 1 odds, which simply means you win 8 times what you bet. It’s a bigger payoff, but the
odds of a tie occurring are much lower.*

Text on screen:

PlaySmart Tip: Ties offer lower odds of winning but higher payouts

Voiceover:

*Each hand gets two cards and they are dealt face up. There’s no place to hide! The winning hand is the
one that is closest to a total of 9.*

Text on screen:

PlaySmart Tip: The hand with the total closest to 9 wins.



Voiceover:

So how can you get close to 9 if some cards seem to be worth more...like 10s and face cards? Well, unlike other table games, in Mini Baccarat, face cards are worth 0 and cards 2 through 9 are worth their face value.

Text on screen:

PlaySmart Tip: Tens and face cards are worth zero. Aces are worth 1.

Voiceover:

Let's say one of the hands has a 9 and a 6, for a total of 15.

Text on screen:

PlaySmart Tip: When a hand totals over 9, subtract 10 to get the value of your hand.

Voiceover:

When the total goes over 9, like I am showing here, we subtract 10 to get the value of the hands, which is 5. So that also means 14 is worth 4 points, 13 is worth 3, 12 is worth 2 and so on. Aces are worth 1 point.

Text on screen:

PlaySmart Tip: Ask your dealer to learn more about 3rd card rules.

Voiceover:

A third card can be drawn depending on what's in the Banker's and Player's hands. However, this only happens if one of the hands has a total of 5 or less.

Text on screen:

PlaySmart Tip: Mini Baccarat is a game of chance.

Voiceover:

Something to be aware of...Mini Baccarat is a game of chance. Betting based on what seem like streaks or patterns won't give you an edge. Let's go have some fun and play smart!
