



PlaySmart – ‘Get Your Game On’– Props

Text on screen:

PlaySmart
‘Get Your Game On’ – PROPS

Video:

Nigel, the host, walks onto the stage resembling the set of a game-show, with his guest, Josh, already present on stage.

Nigel Speaks:

Oh, hi. Oh! hey, hey! PlaySmart presents: Get Your Game On, where we learn how to make picks in Props with confidence, so you can amp up the excitement in your game. Welcome to the show, Josh.

Josh Speaks:

Hey, hey!

Nigel Speaks:

Nice jersey!

Josh Speaks:

Ooh, nice suit!

Video:

Logos of Pro-Line, Pools, Props, and Point Spread appears.

Nigel Speaks:

Well, thank you very much. So, first things first. OLG offers four different sports lottery games: Pro-line, Pools, Props, and Point Spread. How much do you know about sports betting?

Josh Speaks:

Well, I'm a big sports fan, but I don't know that much about sports betting. Bunch of my friends make bets on the games and I want in on the action.

Nigel Speaks:

Perfect, because today we'll be learning how to play Props.

Josh Speaks:

Sweet, let's get started!

Nigel Speaks:

Let's! So tell me what you know about the game.

Josh Speaks:

I think this is the one where we can bet on the players, right?

Nigel Speaks:

Yeah! I mean, not only that, Props is like playing a game within a game. You can wager on a range of things within 3 to 6 sporting events. You can bet on specific actions in a game and go much deeper than just the overall score.

Josh Speaks:

Cool!

Nigel Speaks:

Right? Let's start by going over the steps you'd take before buying a Props ticket.

Text on screen:

STEP 1: SET YOUR BUDGET

Nigel Speaks:

The first step to sports betting is setting your budget. Savvy sports bettors know that in sports, anything can happen. That's why it's best to set aside a play budget and only use money you can afford to spend.

Josh Speaks:

Sounds like a smart idea.

Nigel Speaks:

Okay, now onto making your bets.

Text on screen:

STEP 2: SET YOUR WAGER & MAKE YOUR PICKS



Video:

LEGAL:

Selection slip, app and events may not be exactly as shown.

Nigel Speaks:

You can wager as little as \$2 to as much as \$100 per PROPS ticket.

Text on screen:

PLAYSMART TIP: No bet is a sure thing. Stick to a play budget.

Nigel Speaks:

But remember, the more you wager, the more you stand to win or lose. So, it's best to stick with your budget.

Josh Speaks:

Okay, now how do I make my picks for Props?

Nigel Speaks:

Ah, well there are two ways to determine your picks and predictions.

Text on screen:

OPTION 1: THE PRO-LINE APP

Nigel Speaks:

The first way is with the Pro-Line app.

Josh Speaks:

I've heard of this app!

Nigel Speaks:

Oh, right on!

Video:

A phone appears with the Pro-Line app opened for visual aid.

Nigel Speaks:

So, you'd just pull up the app, view the events and select your sport. Then, view any related stats, make your predictions and save your picks.

Text on screen:

PLAYSMART TIP: Everything needed to make your PROPS picks is on the PRO-LINE app.

Nigel Speaks:

And when you head to an OLG retailer, they'll just scan your picks and give you a ticket for purchase.

Text on screen:

OPTION 2: ONLINE OR IN STORE

Video:

A ticket appears for visual aid.

Nigel Speaks:

The second way to play is by getting the Event List on proline.ca, or from any OLG retailer. You'd then make your selections on a paper selection slip in store. Remember how I said that with Props, you can wager on different things within an event?

Josh Speaks:

Yes, sir.

Nigel Speaks:

Well, OLG will set a series of outcomes that may happen in a Props event. For example, in hockey, this includes things like shots on goal, assists, or face-offs won.

Text on screen:

PLAYSMART TIP: PRO football, PRO basketball, baseball, and hockey available.

Nigel Speaks:

Once OLG sets its predictions, then you can pick whether you think a team or player will perform over or under the projected performance.

Josh Speaks:

Right on. And to win, do I need to get all my predictions right, or just some?

Nigel Speaks:

To win, you have to correctly predict the results of all the events you've wagered on.

Josh Speaks:

Right. Okay, so let me see if I've got this down pat.

Nigel Speaks:

Okay.

Josh Speaks:

I set my budget, I make my wager, I make my predictions, and then I buy my ticket?

Nigel Speaks:

You got it!

Josh Speaks:

Alright!

Nigel Speaks:

Then the final step is to check your ticket.

Text on screen:

STEP 3: CHECK YOUR TICKET

Nigel Speaks:

You can check your ticket by heading to an OLG retailer, visiting the website, or using the OLG Lottery app.



Josh Speaks:

Well I've got to check out what games are on tonight.

Nigel Speaks:

Oh, nice. Josh, it sounds like you're ready to make your picks and play smart.

Josh Speaks:

Props to that.

Nigel Speaks:

Props... I see what you did there.

Text on screen:

PlaySmart
Knowledge you can bet on.
